Update on Pablo Araya in Costa Rica

The following is an update on Pablo Araya's hemoglobin condition. We have been reporting on his problem with low red blood cell counts, which has resulted in several blood transfusions over time. It has been recurring, so there has been talk among the doctors that the problem may be with his spleen, and that removing the spleen would solve the problem.

The following are the last two translated reports sent by his father, Danny, GPA Missionary in Costa Rica.

His hemoglobin is dropping again, he is very brave, he doesn't complain, but we notice that at least he is calm and can go to church and study. On Monday is his appointment with the specialist

The specialist has already seen Pablo, and based on the test results, she believes that his problem is not in his spleen but in his bone marrow. This Wednesday, God willing, they will perform more in-depth tests. On the same Wednesday, they will perform another blood transfusion. On Thursday, May 8, they will perform a bone marrow biopsy, and on the 19th they will see him again to see the results.

Please keep Pablo in your prayers, and may the doctors be led by God's sovereign and merciful hands.
