He is waiting in Galilee:

One of the things that I have been doing since arriving to the US is helping prepare messages for the guys in Bolivia. While finishing up our study on the book of Matthew, I was recently preparing the message for Matthew 28:16-20 which is focused on the Great Commission. I feel like you could imagine the disciples asking the question, "Now what"? They were all alone, fearful for their lives, maybe even feeling like everything had come to an end, "but" they remembered that Jesus had told them that He would be waiting for them in Galilee. Not knowing what would come next, the first step they took was to simple obey what the Lord had told them. They were still submitted and trusting what He had told them that He would be there waiting for them. I think that too often we might feel like there is no hope, maybe that we have failed Him too many times, and that He is probably even tired of giving us another chance. Well, I can promise you the same as with the disciples "He is waiting in Galilee". He hasn't forgotten about you and He is not through with you. All you have to do is submit to Him and trust Him. He is waiting to receive you with open arms and prepare you to do great things for Him.

Keep the Main thing the Main thing:

Both Beth and I have started the new semester teaching at the *Vision School of Missions*. This semester Beth is teaching "Women teaching the Bible" and I am teaching "Church Planting II" (Leader Training). My class is focused on the second and maybe most important stage of church planting, is training leadership for the church, so that it can continue many years into the future. Although we are just getting started with the class, I am excited about going over issues that I personally struggled with when we first began in the ministry. I knew "what" I was supposed to do, but not all the details of "how" to do it. For the remainder of the semester, we are going to be talking about biblical examples of leader training, how to identify potential leaders, and the actual process of how to work in someone's life to help them arrive to their leadership potential. We pray that this class will help these future missionaries be better prepared for the task that lies before them.

Catching Up:

We have always been very grateful for the faithful prayers and support from all of our churches through the years, and many of our supporters have been with us since the very beginning. This furlough we have been able to visit some of our supporting churches that during our first visit with them we still didn't have children and now going back to visit we are almost without children again. It has been really great to catch up and we are truly humbled that so many have allowed us to represent them for so many years.
