“Jesus Paid It All”

Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, He said, Father, into thy hands I commend my Spirit: and having said thus, He gave up the ghost.

The bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ is vitally important to believers because it defines who we are and it is the bedrock of the Christian faith. No one can be a Christian without acknowledging the resurrection, for it is the very core of the Gospel. This may sound overstated, but to say anything less is to disregard what the resurrection of Christ is and what it accomplished.

Jesus promised the Jews that He would raise Himself from the dead. He said, “Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up” (John 2:19). He also told them that His resurrection would be the sign that they were seeking. “For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale’s belly; so shall the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth (Matthew 12:40).

We may think that Jesus’ death and shed blood were the perfect sacrifice for our sin, and we would be right. However, if Jesus had not risen from the dead, his death would not mean anything “and if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins” (1 Corinthians 15:17).

The resurrection of Jesus Christ proves His righteousness. If Jesus Christ had not been perfectly righteous, He would not have deserved to live again after He died. Also, it is only by His resurrection that we can be justified (Declared Righteous) by

faith” (Romans 5:1) We do not become righteous by our own efforts, but by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8-9). Then we live in (His) righteousness by the power of Jesus Christ’s resurrection.

1 Corinthians 15:55-56 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
