Urgent, Pablo Araya Update

I want to share an update with you regarding Pablito's health.

We give thanks to God because he is feeling well and remains stable. This has been a true blessing for us amidst this entire trial.

However, we have received the results of a test called a chimerism assay, which helps evaluate whether the bone marrow transplant he received yielded the expected outcome. These results show Sofía—his donor—at 0%, and Pablo at 100%. Simply put, the test indicates that Pablo has likely rejected his sister's bone marrow graft, and that the transplant was unsuccessful.

I have no words to explain what we felt when we saw these results, the sadness and pain of knowing that it didn't work. Nevertheless, the specialist explained to us that there is a possibility the laboratory made an error in analyzing the samples, and that this result may be incorrect. For this reason, Pablo has already undergone a second test to confirm whether this is the case. If the results come back the same, the next step would be to perform a bone marrow biopsy—and likely consider a second bone marrow transplant—meaning we would have to start all over again.

As a family, we are only human, and this news has struck us right in the heart; yet, we continue to place our trust in the Lord. We are human, and naturally, this news causes us deep concern; however, we also know that God is in control. We do not wish to navigate this experience from a place of fear, but rather from a place of faith, hope, and trust in the One who has sustained us thus far—and whom we know will continue to sustain us, come what may and whatever His holy will may be.

That is why we ask you once again to join us in prayer: prayer for strength for Pablito; for peace in our hearts as a family; for wisdom for the doctors; and—should this initial result indeed be an error—that the upcoming test will confirm this with a different outcome.

But also—should it turn out not to be an error—we pray that God grants us the strength to face whatever lies ahead, that He sustains Pablo through every step of this journey, and that the name of our Lord may be glorified throughout this entire process. We continue to believe that Pablito is in God's hands. Our desire and prayer is to see him healthy, strong, and full of life—that God may have the final say and that His will be done.

Thank you for your prayers, for your love, and for standing with us throughout this entire trial; please do not cease praying for us. God bless you.
