## **“Thoughts To Ponder”**

### **“God’s Miracles”**

Mark 6:52 For they considered not the miracle of the loaves: for their heart was hardened.


The scriptures speak of a time when Jesus’ miracles and teachings didn’t have much effect on His disciples. I wonder how much effect the miracles and the teachings of Jesus Christ have on our lives today. Is God still in the miracle working business ... or has that time passed?

Every time that I see a newborn baby, I know that God is still in the miracle working business.

Mark 6:52 states the reason for their lack; ... they considered not the miracle of the loaves and fishes. We should be able to relate to this because sometimes we too feel uninspired about God’s kingdom. Our faith can be strengthened as we study this account.

We learn that Jesus cares. He knows about those who faint. Does anyone even notice our silent struggles? ... JESUS DOES. Perhaps it has been a long spiritual struggle to get where we are today. Jesus notices those who have come a long way and have gone through many trials ... He understands the need of our hearts better than we do ourselves.
