Please also pray for Kata this summer that God would minister to her heart and continue drawing her closer to salvation.

God has also given us some more quality time with the family of two kids who come to our Special Olympics program on Wednesdays. I have enjoyed getting to know the father, Attila. We are praying for their salvation. It would be great to meet more families with children with special needs to be able to minister to them both in a practical way as well as spiritual.

Thank you for praying as well for the men in this group of believers. I have had several opportunities in the past few weeks especially to spend time with them and communicate. One meeting in particular was an answer to prayer as I met one man and his son at a park randomly with my kids.

It was a blessing to have many of the believers present for our service together this past Sunday. Please do pray for them this summer while we are gone. One family just lost their mother/wife to leukemia this week. We greatly look forward to starting up again in person with renewed vision in September and looking into renting a place in town.

Many of you have been praying for Andrew's salvation. A few weeks ago, he asked Sarah at bedtime if he could be saved. I believe he understood it clearly, and even prayed his own prayer by himself. I believe both our children understand the finality of their decision.

On the house front, we did successfully complete the sale of our home in Nyíregyháza. While I was out there the first week of June signing the sale

contract, I was able to visit our good friend Viki and her husband Tibi. Viki has such a sweet passion for God and the gospel. Please keep praying for her. We still have not been able to find a suitable home to buy here in Nagykanizsa, and we will resume that effort when we return at the end of August. We appreciate your prayers for that. There would be a lot of advantages to being downtown, but not a lot is available right now.
