As part of our English teaching in the high school, I have a one-on-one meeting each week with László, the principal, who wants to get more confidence in speaking English. He has a Lutheran upbringing, but would identify as a Buddhist now. I shared my salvation testimony pretty extensively with him last week, which was a blessing. He remarked that I talked with depth and confidence about Christianity, which he had never experienced before. I told him that if the Lutheran priest didn't have confidence of eternal life, he probably couldn't speak with conviction about that. Please pray for him.

This Wednesday, I will have another one-on-one teaching opportunity with a man who works for a multinational company here. He and his wife came to look at the house we rent, since it is for sale now. We have a number of mutual friends with them, but we had never met before. Please pray for this opportunity each week to have contact with Gábor.

Our time on Sundays with the believers here has been a blessing. Please continue to pray for God to strengthen them and give them confidence to move forward for Him by faith. Peter, a believer, recently lost his wife to cancer. He has been in contact with several from this group, and has expressed that he would like to start joining us. Please pray especially for him. One of the ladies in our group organized a get-together at her house in a few weeks for the purpose of inviting Peter to spend time with us as a group.

Our residence permits are in progress here, as well as the mortgage application with the bank for the new house. We appreciate your continued prayers for these things.
